Transports Publics 2008, the third edition of the European mobility exhibition

The **Transports Publics 2008 exhibition** will be bringing together urban, inter-urban and regional transport professionals from across France and the rest of Europe: organising authorities, operators, industrial players, manufacturers and sub-contractors (for buses, coaches, trams, metros, trains, etc.) with some 200 exhibitors and **25 000 sqm** of exhibition space. **10 000 visitors** are expected.

The exhibition is a landmark event for the trade, **promoting public transport and sustainable travel**, with plenty of space given over to 'soft modes' such as cycles, car-pooling and car-sharing.

Alongside the GIE Objectif Transport Public, which represents the GART (Transportation Authority Group) and the UTP (Public and Rail Transport Union), the European organising committee also features two **guests of honour** for 2008: the Lisbon network Carris and the Brussels network STIB.

The European showcase for innovations in public transport

The exhibition brings together all the latest innovations in terms of equipment, techniques and management deployed across Europe, with a dedicated Innovation Track and the Public Transport Innovation Awards under the auspices of the Minister for Transport.

An exhibition focusing on the latest industry news and developments

Increasingly international transport markets, deregulation, the growing need for passenger-friendly, sustainable transport systems... the exhibition will be highlighting **European policy advances** in these fields, providing the opportunity to assess European exports and skills, and setting out the priorities for France's upcoming European presidency with respect to sustainable mobility.

Innovative businesses, industry experts, decision-makers and purchasers will be there to look at in-field applications illustrating the kind of issues and challenges Europe faces today and in the near future.
