With 25,000sqm of exhibition space, Transports Publics 2008 is an excellent opportunity to find out about all the latest innovations being brought out by its 220 international exhibitors. Whether technological or organisational in nature, the industry's innovations are providing new solutions contributing to sustainable mobility.

In partnership with Veolia Transport and *Transport Public* magazine, the Public Transport Innovation Awards are being presented during the Exhibition, honouring the best innovations in industry and services in three categories. A panel of experts (composed of members of the ADEME, the FNAUT, the INRETS, the French Ministry of Ecology, Energy, Sustainable Development and Planning, the Ministry of the Economy, Finance, Industry and Employment, and the Transport Economy Laboratory) has shortlisted three nominees in each of these categories:

- Alstom's Citadis Dualis tram-train.
- The Crealis Neo, the new High Service Level Bus from Irisbus Iveco.

Three award-winning entries from among these nine nominees will be announced at **the official Awards ceremony, which will take place on Thursday, June 12 at 3.30pm at the "Carrefour de l'Europe" in the presence of Dominique Bussereau, French Secretary of State for Transport.**
